



**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING  
ACADEMIC COOPERATION  
BETWEEN  
FUDAN UNIVERSITY  
AND  
THE UNIVERSITY OF AUCKLAND**

The President of Fudan University and the Vice-Chancellor of the University of Auckland hereby propose to foster academic exchange and cooperation between the two institutions.

1. The two institutions will encourage the following activities in particular:
  - i) Exchange of materials, publications and information
  - ii) Exchange of professors and research staff
  - iii) Exchange of students
  - iv) Joint research and meetings for research
2. These activities are to be carried out after mutual consultation between the two institutions or the divisions concerned thereof. Normally each institution will sign a letter of agreement setting out the responsibilities of each institution for the agreed activity and such other matters as the institutions agree are necessary for the efficient achievement of the activity.
3. Amendment of this Memorandum is to be effected by written agreement of the two institutions. No such amendment or revision will come into effect until both institutions have agreed in writing to this amendment or revision
4. This Memorandum shall be effective upon approval by both parties in writing and shall remain in effect for a term of five years. Thereafter, subject to a review by each institution which confirms the Memorandum is achieving the objectives set out above, it shall be renewed for a further term of five years as may be agreed by both parties in writing. However, after the initial term either institution may terminate the Agreement at the end of a given academic year by giving six months' notice in writing of such intent, provided that termination by one party shall not affect any activities already approved under this Memorandum.
