### 1. Aims:

- To provide primary students a platform to demonstrate their Chinese language proficiency
- To inspire their interest in learning Chinese
- To lay a solid foundation for them to maintain their passion and enthusiasm in learning a secondary language

### 6. Theme Topic:

**Chinese, Joy & Fun! 快乐中文**

### 7. Format:

The format for 2023 "Chinese Bridge" Primary Student Category is flexible. The participating item can be to make a short speech in Chinese (1-2 minutes long), to demonstrate a Chinese talent show, to sing a song in Chinese, or to play a game in Chinese, etc. The performance can be individual, in pairs or in small group. In assessing their performance, the following three aspects will be considered particularly: clarity, fluency and confidence.

## 8. Eligibility:

- 1) Full-time enrolled primary school (including home school) student (13 years old and below) in the wider Auckland region (including Waikato and Northland).
- 2) All contestants' native language must NOT be Chinese. Neither parents (living with the student) should be native speakers of Chinese.

**Please note:**

**All the students who participate in the competition MUST bring a copy of their passport photo page on the competition day.**

## 9. Awards:

The top winner of the national competition (accompanied by a parent/guardian) will represent New Zealand to participate in the finals that will happen in China in August/September.

## 10. Registration:

The regional competition is open to all primary school students in the wider Auckland region (including Waikato and Northland). Each school can register a maximum of six students. Schools are encouraged to organize their own preliminaries. Individual student should register with her/his Chinese teacher so that the teacher can complete the registration template (please refer to the separate attached Registration Template), submit the school group registration to Confucius Institute in Auckland by Saturday 6th May 2023.
